

PRIMARY SCHOOL

- · Welcome back after the short break! The rest of the second term is going to be very busy, with it being an exam term, as well as preparing for the concert at the end of July.
- The examination timetable for the Grade 4 to 7 learners is attached to this newsletter. The exams in the Primary School start on 2 June, and will end on 13 June. The revision timetable has also been given to the learners.
- · For the last two weeks of the term, 18-27 June, the Senior Primary learners will be back in class. The teachers will be going through the exam scripts and starting Term 3 work. In this period, final rehearsals for the concert will take place. The Foundation Phase learners will continue as normal during the month of June.
- · As from the first day of the exams, 2 June, until the second last day of term, 26 June, school will end at 12h00 for all Primary School learners, Grade RRR to Grade 7. On the last day of school, 27 June, school will end at 11h00.
- During the 4 week period in June, after care will continue as normal. There will also be a study/homework class every day from 12h00 till 14h00, for both after care and non-after care learners.
- · Thank you to those parents who have already paid the R300 concert fee. If you have not yet done so, please pay by **16 May**.
- · Rehearsals for the concert are going well-with every single Primary School learner involved. We have some very talented young girls and boys at Loreto!

- · Afternoon sport and activities continue until 23 May. If a child is unable to attend on a particular day, he/she needs to excuse themselves at the responsible teacher. Our netball teams still have a few more matches against other schools during the next few weeks.
- The Boyz Club takes place on Wednesday afternoons, from 15h00 till 16h30. The boys have a lot of fun and also learn a lot every week. Please ensure that your son is neatly dressed in his sports clothes for this activity.
- Extra lessons continue until the end of May. Please encourage your child to make the most of this opportunity and arrive on time for the start of class. Letters have been sent home, should your child need to attend extra lessons in English, Afrikaans or Mathematics. If you did not receive a letter and would like your child to attend, please send your child to Ms Hill for a letter. Extra lessons take place between 13h30 and 14h00 Monday to Thursday afternoons. Afternoon sport ends at 15h00.
- ·All learners should now be in full winter uniform, which includes a tie, a long-sleeved white shirt and long blue socks. The girls may wear the blue stockings which can be purchased from the uniform shop.
- ·Learners in Grade 4-7 may only wear their sports clothes or tracksuit on their Phys-Ed day.
- The Grade 7 learners will be attending their annual retreat on 14 May, during the school morning. The Grade 6 learners will have their retreat on 21 May.
- The learners taking part in the Bible Quiz final taking place on 23 May, will be announced soon.
- •The Grade 7 learners will be attending a Mass with all the other Catholic Schools at Loreto Queenswood on Friday 16 May. A letter has been sent to the Grade 7 parents.

Kindly note that the change in dates for Gr 10 – 12 is due to the Department of Education's late notice in the submission of statistics (due 26 June). On the day where Gr 11 – 12 have a double session, the learners will end at 14h00. An amended timetable with amended logistics has been given to all learners and uploaded onto our website. Please also refer to the grade scope for more details.

All learners will have class in the last week. Teachers will run through the memoranda so that learners have the opportunity to work through errors and understand better the marks they received.

Learners must also ensure that they are on time for line-up at 7h30 and therefore on time to go into the exam venue.

Gr 8 and 9 learners will have their own venue and seat for the duration of the exams. While Gr 10 – 12 will change daily and will take place mostly in the school hall. Learners will know their seat once they walk through the gates. It will be posted on the board at the entrance.

Of importance is that all learners have a transparent pencil bag with blue pens, a pencil, an eraser, a sharpener and a stapler. No sharing of these items will be allowed. Please note that the exam session will end at 11h00. Learners can be fetched from the Nana Sita Street entrance until 12h00 and thereafter from the Visagie Street entrance. Learners who are still at school at 12h00 will go into the Music Centre for study until 14h00.

Teachers will also be available to help learners with subject queries from 11h00 to 12h00. It is important that teachers are approached by the learner beforehand to organise an appointment.

Digital or electronic watches, beanies, scarves, blankets and hot water bottles will NOT be allowed in exam venues, as these are regulations stipulated by the Department of Education. Any learner at any time may be searched in the exam venue, as per exam rules and regulations.

During the June exam period, learners may wear the school's sports uniform (tracksuit) as it is more comfortable. Beneath the school's tracksuit top, learners should only be wearing the polo shirt and school's pullover or jersey. No learner should be wearing polar or turtle neck tops and should not be wearing tekkies of all colours, predominantly white tekkies only must be worn.

ABSENTEEISM

Many learners are absent from school without a plausible reason. Please parents, ensure that your daughter is not absent unnecessarily especially during assessments. Know your daughters' whereabouts as many learners do take chances. Please take note of the Assessment Policy on our school's website.

Although we are an independent school, we still have to adhere to the Department of Education's regulations. Learners with more than 20 days absent, may not sit for the November exams. Learners without a doctor's note will get zero (0) for a missed assessment.

BLOOD DRIVE

On 6 May we had our second Blood Drive. Well done to all learners who donated for their courage and civic sense of duty.

OLYMPIADS

We had a number of Olympiads this month (Afrikaans, Business Studies and the 2nd round Mathematics). We are eagerly awaiting the results.
