EXTRA LESSONS HAVE ALSO STARTED AND ARE PROGRESSING WELL. THERE ARE, HOWEVER, LEARNERS WHO DO NOT WILLINGLY ATTEND AND THEREFORE ARE NOT BENEFITING FROM THESE CLASSES. PLEASE ENCOURAGE YOUR CHILD TO MAKE THE MOST OF THIS OPPORTUNITY AND ARRIVE ON TIME FOR THE START OF CLASS. LETTERS HAVE BEEN SENT HOME, SHOULD YOUR CHILD NEED TO ATTEND EXTRA LESSONS IN ENGLISH, AFRIKAANS OR MATHEMATICS. IF YOU DID NOT RECEIVE A LETTER AND WOULD LIKE YOUR CHILD TO ATTEND, PLEASE SEND YOUR CHILD TO MS HILL FOR A LETTER. EXTRA LESSONS TAKE PLACE BETWEEN 13H3O AND 14H0O MONDAY TO THURSDAY AFTERNOONS. AFTERNOON SPORT ENDS AT 15H0O.

•THERE ARE A NUMBER OF LEARNERS WHO REGULARLY ARRIVE LATE FOR SCHOOL. AS FROM MONDAY 19 FEBRUARY, LEARNERS WILL RECEIVE A DEMERIT AFTER BEING LATE THREE TIMES.

THERE HAS BEEN AN ASTONISHING NUMBER OF HOMEWORK DEMERITS ALREADY ISSUED THIS TERM. PARENTS ARE REQUESTED TO PLEASE MONITOR THE HOMEWORK, CHECK THAT IT IS ALL COMPLETED AND ASSIST THE CHILDREN WHERE NECESSARY.

PARENTS ARE KINDLY REQUESTED TO ENSURE THAT THEIR CHILDREN HAVE ALL THE NECESSARY ITEMS OF UNIFORM, INCLUDING THE SCHOOL SWIMMING COSTUME, CAP AND SPORTS CLOTHES. A REMINDER THAT THE GIRLS MAY ONLY WEAR SMALL GOLD OR SILVER STUDS IN THEIR EARS, OR SMALL SLEEPER EARRINGS. NO DIAMANTÉ OR OTHER FANCY EARRINGS ARE ALLOWED. THE CHILDREN'S NAILS MUST PLEASE BE KEPT SHORT AND CLEAN, WITH NO NAIL POLISH ALLOWED. THE CHILDREN ARE NOT ALLOWED TO DYE THEIR HAIR. GRADE 4 TO 7 LEARNERS MUST HAVE A BLAZER TO WEAR TO ASSEMBLIES, MASSES AND OTHER FUNCTIONS.

·ALL FOUNDATION PHASE AND GRADE 4 PARENTS ARE REQUESTED TO SEND IN A BOX OF TISSUES AND A PACKET OF SEALED SWEETS FOR THE TERM. THANK YOU TO THOSE PARENTS WHO HAVE ALREADY DONE SO.

PRIMARY SCHOOL CHILDREN MAY BRING PARTY PACKS TO SCHOOL TO CELEBRATE THEIR BIRTHDAY. A CUP-CAKE FOR EACH CHILD AND NOT BIG CAKES THAT HAVE TO BE CUT MAY BE SENT TOO.

PLEASE SEND IN THE MONEY, TOGETHER WITH A LOCK AND TWO KEYS TO MRS HAUPT, AND A LOCKER WILL BE ALLOCATED.

ALL SENIOR PRIMARY LEARNERS MUST HAVE A NAME BADGE. SHOULD A CHILD NEED TO REPLACE THE BADGE. A NEW ONE CAN BE ORDERED FROM MRS HAUPT AT R30 PER BADGE.




To tie our whole event together we ended the night with club L under shining stars and moonlight. Cupids Casual Carnival was one for the books.
